Dear friends,

There's a lovely worship song by Noel Richards in our hymn books (StF530) which reminds how, like Mary (Luke 10.38-42), we can rest and be in Christ's presence: To be in your presence, To sit at your feet ... This is my desire, O Lord, This is my desire.

I have just returned from a 5 day silent retreat at Lee Abbey where there really is space to sit and rest in God's presence. I felt God prompting me to spend time reflecting on His freely given grace towards everyone – all of us in it together in this messy world: His grace that saves, forgives, restores and gives us all fresh starts when we've got side-tracked.

But we can only go up the mountain to sit with Jesus for a while before we need to come back down and be alongside each other again. And for that, I find these words from hymn StF 611 helpful:

Brother, sister, let me serve you, let me be as Christ to you—pilgrims on a journey - companions on the road - here to help each other, ... hold the Christ-light for (each other) ... hold (our) hand(s) out to (each other). Supermarkets can be pretty anonymous places can't they, and when they are very busy some shoppers can get a bit fractious and impatient. But have you noticed how responsive people can be to a smile, and a bit of giving-way - to a bit of time given for them? In this anonymous setting, I've found people who don't know me have open up to share a worry or concern. I listen.

Sometimes I ask if I can pray for them, other times that doesn't seem quite the right thing to offer – but I do pray anyway. Reaching out, being inclusive, showing kindness and patience are all ways that Jesus demonstrated God's love for everyone, so let's be encouraged as we go out in His presence and do the same. *Pam*
