Dear friends,

Today concludes this year's Week of Prayer for Christian Unity amongst the churches in Crediton. We looked at 2025 being the 1700th Anniversary of the Nicene Creed that Christians, gathered from the churches scattered around different nations at that time, agreed as their shared statement of belief.

The week started with the Picnic in the Park last Sunday, with a lovely time of worship and songs of praise led by Crediton Town Band - and the weather stayed dry for us! There were people from every church, and Christians mixed and mingled together in friendship and fellowship. And then on each of the weekdays, we met in a different church and at the St Boniface statue to pray together.

On Good Friday, we have the joint walk of witness through the town, pausing at each church to pray as one family in Christ – this year it was nick-named the `walk of wetness' for good reason but the weather didn't put us off.

For the World Day of Prayer each March, each church hosts the prayer time in rotation. And for the last couple of years, there's been a monthly ecumenical service for older people in which the bond of fellowship as brothers and sisters in Christ is going from strength to strength.

For me, these times of shared worship draw us and bind us together in our mutual love of Christ Jesus.

So, as we celebrate Pentecost this year, we can reflect on how the Holy Spirit's coming brought together people of different backgrounds and languages to spread the good news of the gospel around the world. Let's pray that that same Holy Spirit will enable us today to be part of God's continuing work in our age. Every blessing, *Pam*
