## Dear Friends,

When Pam, Cathy and I were at the MET “Methodist Evangelical Together” Conference at Torquay a couple of weeks ago, in one of the sessions people were encouraged to share what was happening in their church. The word that was often used to describe their church was “*flourishing*”. Imagine my surprise when I returned home and opened the book I am using for Advent Through to Epiphany this year. There in front of me was the word “*flourishing*”.

“What does it mean to flourish?”

The word implies health, at least, if not vigour and strength. We flourish when we use our capacities to the full, when we achieve something great without completely exhausting ourselves or wrecking all our relationships. A good or true community properly seeks the flourishing of all its members and will not willingly see any diminished.

Flourishing rightly suggests fullness of life, fulfilment, and delight in being active. To flourish is to bloom; to fulfil hidden potential. Flourishing is beautiful – a delight to behold; a wonder to experience. Flourishing brings its own ecstasy. It is so richly, abundantly, entirely complete that it needs to create another dimension.

To flourish, then, is not to stop for long, if at all. It is certainly not to hold our breath. No, we seek all the more earnestly the breath of spirit and the water of life. We look around us again and respond with envy or thanks to the glories of others. We look, stare, long for the light that will lead us – all of us – home, knowing only that our former flourishing was but a foretaste of the flourishing that is yet to come.”

May we find our Church flourishing; not finding ourselves stagnating or going backwards but ever moving forward; ever finding new ways to be like Christ in Crediton. May our heartbeat be centred on Jesus, as in hymn 447:

*Jesus, be the centre, be my source, be my light, Jesus*

*Jesus be the centre, be my hope, by my song, Jesus*

*Jesus, be my vision, be my path, be my guide, Jesus*

*Be the fire in my heart, be the wind in these sails;*

*Be the reason that I live, Jesus, Jesus.*
